





## Background

On March 27, 2020, Governor Greg Abbott issued a press release recognizing child care programs as essential to the state's battle against the COVID-19 pandemic. Many Texans on the frontline of this pandemic, including healthcare workers, are also parents and must rely on safe child care programs to care for their children.

During the COVID-19 emergency, the Frontline Child Care Task Force encourages grocers and other suppliers to allow child care centers to purchase additional quantities of critical supplies such as food, paper products, infant products, and cleaning supplies.

## **Declaration of Need**
